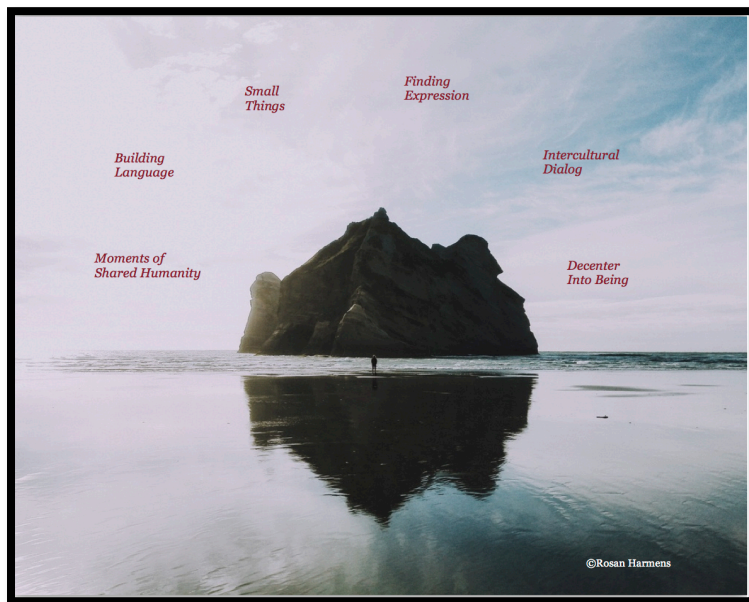
SMALL THINGS – THE HUMAN IN HUMANITARIAN

In 'Yo lo vi', Paul Bouvier talks of the value of "very little things". While he speaks specifically with regards to the humanitarian aid sector, it has much relevance in our lives and particularly so with those of us working with people - humans- all of us? Bouvier talks of "small things... so derisory that they rarely dare to appear in reports, accounts, and media articles on humanitarian action in the field". They may take different shapes: "like a cup of coffee, pictures of flowers, animals, and landscapes, or a few drops of perfume"¹.

Or they may be a particular look or smile, a cigarette shared with a beneficiary, a brief chat with a refugee child, or a sense of shared commitment across one's team or organization. What are these little things actually about? **Paul Bouvier sees them as "intense moments; moments of shared humanity"**.

The role of art making

These moments of the small - moments of shared humanity - are often missed due to the hectic routines and demands of contemporary life. One way to bring them into our awareness is simply the act of interrupting the mundane of the everyday - creating moments - **little irregularities interrupting the daily chain of repetition** - the intentional stopping to look at the clouds, or appreciate a tree. Art making has a very similar affect in that it allows us to create these special situations within the everyday reality.

Strict reproduction of the same in everyday life is the path which inevitably takes us to being "cynical, cautious, bureaucratic, self-interested, inefficient and we prefer to sit with our laptops rather than with people suffering around us."² **Hugo Slim** rightly reminds us in a recent book oh **Humanitarian Ethics** that virtue, i.e. a particular form of strength, needs to be "cultivated carefully" to be a humanitarian. **Little things** that bring meaning, beauty and intensity to our life and work are possibly the most essential ingredients of this cultivation.

Objectives:

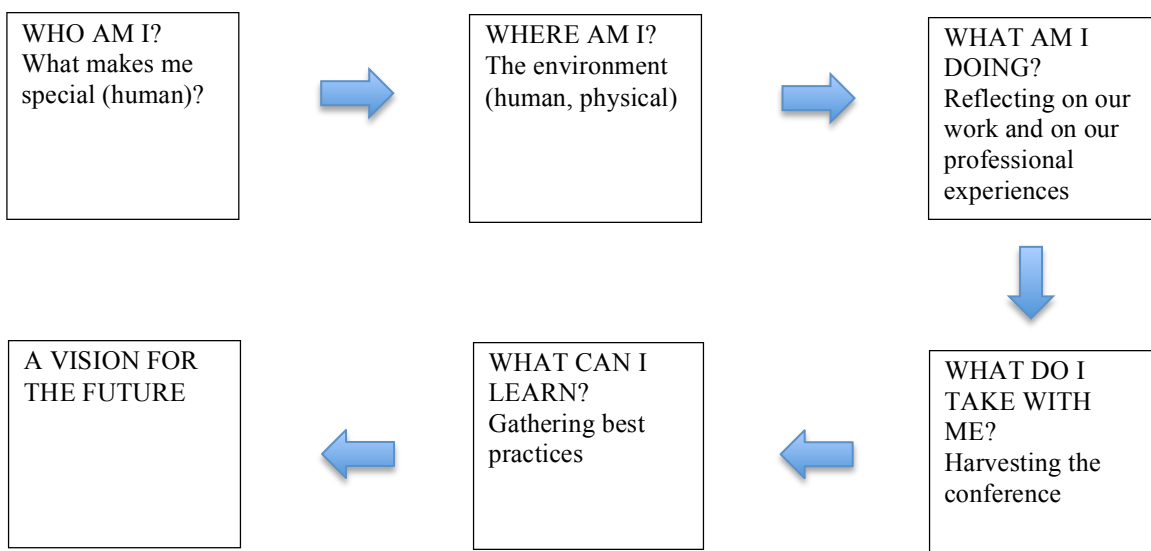
1. To explore the concept of *humanity* from a personal perspective
2. To explore how our concept of humanity affects our approach to ourselves and the environment
3. To acknowledge and celebrate our individual and collective humanness
4. To create a manifesto/shared vision for the future

Methodology

The three-day Seminar is an opportunity for participants to reflect upon their personal and professional lives through art making and creativity in order to examine the concept under discussion. Further, it is an excellent networking and sharing platform and a demonstration of how the arts can be used for such a discourse. Finally it is an opportunity to simply enjoy the life-affirming pleasures of art making.

The Seminar will include individual and group art-making activities and incorporate presentations and group discussions. Each of the sections shown in the flow-chart below will be explored simultaneously through multiple methods that include:

- Presentations/talks from the field from selected guests
- Art making sessions
- Discussion groups
- Performances
- Developing a vision

This 800-hour training includes experiential discovery through the arts, theory and philosophy of practice and engagement of the methods of arts-based therapy through fieldwork and reflective practice. This program offers a unique perspective that fosters the understanding of theory, principles and practices to support social change and social action. Graduates can choose to apply their learning in a range of fields such as one-on-one expressive arts therapy, education, health and wellness, community organizations, community service and social activism.

At the Vancouver School of Expressive Arts Therapy we are interested in creating a collaborative learning community. We seek to discover new and creative ways to shape and engage our learning in the field of expressive arts therapy and are committed to teaching and learning through the experiential, theoretical and practical application of our work. There is value placed on flexibility, non-traditional and traditional methods of education, active and reflective models of learning, and self-directed study.

Our training is suitable for those who wish to obtain an Expressive Arts Therapy diploma or for those who are eligible to continue their studies and pursue a Masters degree with the European Graduate School.

The full-time program takes six months to complete and runs March through August. Students are in class Monday - Wednesday and some evenings.

The part-time program extends over a ten-month period that begins in the fall of each year. Classes are scheduled on Wednesday evenings and over 15 intensive weekends, so that students are able to maintain their personal and working life commitments.

As psychiatric health care moved on to smaller units, huge hospitals became unnecessary and too costly. Many businessmen planned to make the Lapinlahti hospital to a 5-star hotel with a wide garden and park by the sea. Luckily the house got full protection by the Museum Authorities and the hotel plans had to be dropped.

Now the Lapinlahti building is being renovated under the umbrella organization *Finnish Mental Health Care Association*, which is renting rooms for artists, therapists, health care organizations and associations. Inartes Institute will be in good company!



Inartes will have beautiful training rooms and cozy therapy rooms plus office. In the building there are also the Auditorium, Art Gallery, Cafe, Lunch restaurants and small shops. All this will attract visitors on every day basis.

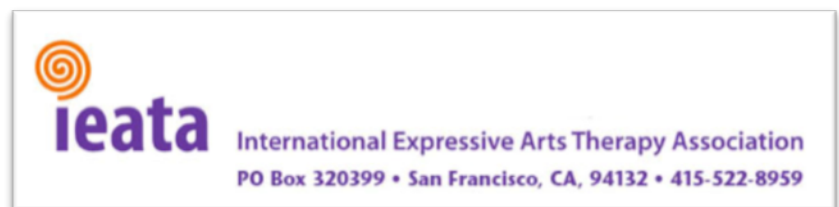

THE CREATE INSTITUTE TORONTO

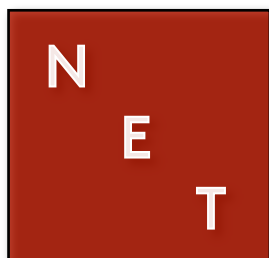
We have changed our name from ISIS Canada to The Create Institute.
